Recreation Program and Camp Expectations

To provide a safe and welcoming environment we ask all participants and their families and staff to follow the Caring Code:

- Take Care of Yourself
- Take Care of Others
- Take Care of This Place

Examples of violations:

- Kicking, biting/ hitting others
- Leaving space without consent
- Using inappropriate language and behaviour to staff/others
- Damages to facility/equipment
- Where there are violations to the Recreation Program Expectations, including where the health and safety of participants/staff or volunteer is impacted, other options for support may be discussed, up to including withdrawal from program. * where applicable a pro-rated refund will be processed.
