




Building a Fence - Fence Height Regulations

A fence is defined in the Zoning Bylaw as a vertical structure used for enclosure or screening where the thickness is equal to, or less than, 8cm (0.26 ft.) excluding top and bottom rail posts. Height is measured from finished grade.

The illustration below indicates maximum fence heights as applied to a typical residential lot:
