Re: 2026 Transportation Upgrades – Maple Street at Elgin Avenue Raised Intersection

Please be advised that the City is currently within the design phase of the upcoming Capital Works construction project to take place in your area. The graphic labeled **Maple Street** on page 2 further depicts the intersection improvements to take place.

The scope of work includes:

- New raised intersection at Maple Street and Elgin Avenue;
- New pedestrian letdowns at east leg of intersection.

The purpose of this project is to improve pedestrian safety and visibility for motorists of pedestrians on the crosswalks while also reducing vehicle speeds approaching the intersection.

Construction is anticipated to begin in Summer 2026. Although we will attempt to minimize major inconveniences to property owners, typical construction delays and disruptions may occur due to the nature and extent of the proposed work. All residents in the area will be informed of a proposed schedule by the Contractor in advance to minimize inconvenience.

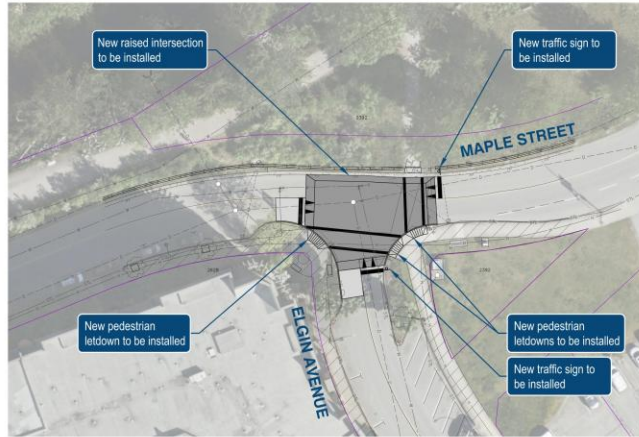
