Recycling Glass the Right Way

Port Coquitlam provides curbside glass collection to households receiving City waste services.

Follow these simple steps to recycle your glass correctly:



SELECT non-refundable

glass bottles and jars only.

REMOVE lids and caps

and put in blue cart if metal or plastic.

RINSE

food residue from glass before recycling.

Please take refundable bottles to a depot. Learn more: portcoquitlam.ca/glass.

Are You Feeding the Bears?

If you're not securing your carts and other attractants, you could be bringing bears into your neighbourhood.

Once bears become used to human food sources, they may require action from Conservation Officers.

Secure all attractants to keep bears safe and avoid a fine.

LOCK IT UP




- Secure attractants in a garage, shed, or with an approved cart lock.
- Pick ripe fruit and berries.
- Clean your barbecue after every use.
- Keep pet food and bird seed out of reach.

SET IT



- Only set out unlocked carts at the curb between 5:30-7:30 am on collection day [leave at least 1 m (3 ft) between carts].
- Secure them again by 7 pm.



Collection Zones

Collection is weekly for green carts (organics), biweekly for blue (recycling) and grey (garbage) carts, and monthly for grey bins (glass). Find your collection day info:
