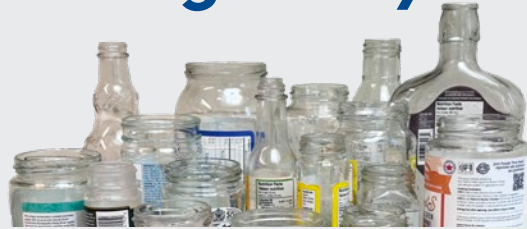

Recycling Glass the Right Way

Port Coquitlam provides curbside glass collection to households receiving City waste services.

Follow these simple steps to recycle your glass correctly:



SELECT
non-refundable
glass bottles
and jars only.

REMOVE
lids and caps
and put in blue cart
if metal or plastic.

RINSE
food residue
from glass
before recycling.

Are You Feeding the Bears?

If you're not securing your carts and other attractants, you could be bringing bears into your neighbourhood.

Once bears become used to human food sources, they may require action from Conservation Officers.

Secure all attractants to keep bears safe and avoid a fine.

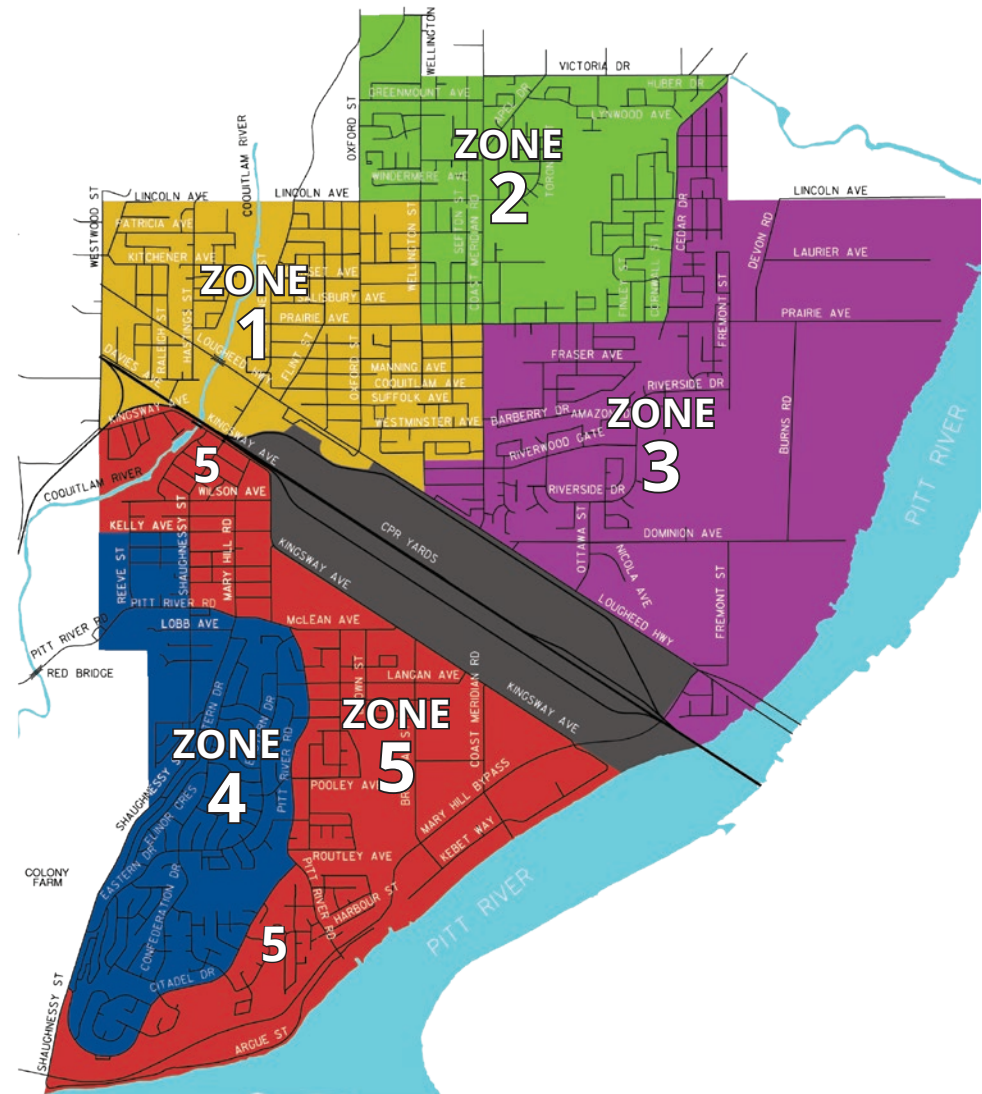


- Secure attractants in a garage, shed, or with an approved cart lock.

- Keep pet food and bird seed out of reach.

- Only set out unlocked carts at the curb between 5:30-7:30 am on collection day [leave at least 1 m (3 ft) between carts].
- Secure them again by 7 pm.

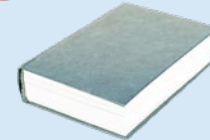
