

Recreation Program and Camp Expectations

Port Coquitlam programs and camps provide families with a variety of safe, fun and inclusive indoor and outdoor activities. We strive to provide opportunities for participants to be active, creative, and to connect with their peers and make new friends.

To provide a safe and welcoming environment in our camps and programs we ask all participants, their families, volunteers and staff to follow the Recreation Caring Code:

- Take Care of Yourself
- Take Care of Our Space
- Take Care of Others

The Caring Code is consistent with the Recreation Department's User Code of Conduct and violations to this code could result in the loss of facility privileges.

Leaders will review the Program and Camp Expectations regularly and will remind and redirect participants., when required. Parents are asked to support staff by reviewing these expectations in advance with your child/youth and to collaborate with staff to find strategies for improvement when expectations are not being met. With advance notice, and if available, additional supports may be an option.

Examples of violations of this Code could include, but are not limited to:

- Leaving the group or space without a leader's consent
- Not following the leader's instructions
- Using inappropriate language, being rude, or bullying behaviour
- Damaging a facility, grounds or equipment
- Any form of physical violence

Serious infractions of this code, particularly if the health or safety for any participant, staff or volunteer becomes a concern could result in the participant being asked to leave the program for the day, or to withdraw from the program. If applicable a pro-rated refund may be processed.
