## Site Identification Questionnaire

Effective February 1, 2021, the new Site Identification process is legislated by *Environmental Management Amendment Act, 2019 (Bill17)* and *Contaminated Sites Regulation OIC 0368/2020* to identify contaminated sites and bring them to the attention of the *Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy* to ensure investigation and remediation occurs prior to redevelopment.

A **Site Identification Questionnaire** is required when the City receives the following permit applications: **Subdivision, Rezoning, Development, or Building Permit** for commercial or industrial sites. For residential or agricultural sites, the applicant may have to complete the **Site Identification Questionnaire** upon request of the File Manager to declare if specific industrial/commercial activities have occurred on site either currently and historically. ### TO BE COMPLETED BY APPLICANT

I/WE UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES THE FAILURE ON PART OF THE CITY TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME/US FROM THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS REFERRED TO ABOVE;**
- TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE CITY** against all claims, liabilities, judgments, costs (including legal fees on a solicitor/client basis), and expenses of whatever kind, which may in any way accrue against the City in consequence of, and incidental to, the granting of this Permit, if issued; and
- This Release and Indemnity survives the expiration of the Permit, if issued, and shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity.

This prohibition can be lifted when the applicant provides the City of Port Coquitlam with a copy of one of the following documents: *Determination that the site is not contaminated, an Approval in Principle of a remediation plan, a Certificate of Compliance or a Voluntary Remediation Agreement; or obtains a Release Notice* from the ministry.
