**AGE REQUIREMENTS – PRE-REGISTERED PUBLIC SKATES**

- **Family Play and Skate** - All ages permitted when attending with family or guardian to play together. Program designed for young children accompanied by a parent or guardian 16yrs+ on skates
- **Public & Toonie Skates**
  - Must be 8 to independently skate, 7 and under and must be accompanied on the ice by a guardian 16yrs+ on skates
  - Children 11yrs and under must wear a CSA hockey or boarding helmet; strongly recommended for all skaters.

**AGE REQUIREMENTS - PRE-REGISTERED RING, STICK AND PUCK**

- Ring, Stick and Puck – Age 4 and up, and for safety program for those who can independently skate and have required equipment
- Must be 8yrs to independently skate, under 8yrs must be accompanied on the ice by a guardian 16yrs+ on skates
- Children 18yrs and under must wear CSA hockey with face cage, 19+helmet mandatory face cage strongly recommended.

**FAMILY PLAY and SKATE**

- Program designed for young children. Families and their young children **must** attend and play together
- Interactive ice activities include toys, fun skate aids, learn to skate and learn to fun hockey zones, no organized drills permitted
- Staff support new skaters with fundamental skating skills
- Strollers permitted, 18 months up requires helmet offered for free.

**PRE-REGISTRATION**

- Create an [online](#) account (one-time set up)
- Pre-register and pay for admission and rentals [online](#) 2 days in advance or call **604-927-7529 (PLAY)** or drop in if spots available
- Registration opens at 8am for PoCo residents and 10am for others
- Equipment rentals available: 1/\$3.57 skate and 1/\$2.42 helmet
- One City Admission is valid for drop-in programs for the duration of the day, at any city facility based on schedule and occupancy.

**PROGRAM NOTES**

- Limited supply of skating aids available, personal skating aids not permitted. Use of skating aids requires use of helmet too
- For the enjoyment and safety of all customers, lap skating only
- External private lessons are not permitted
- Strollers & wheelchairs permitted on ice and require a helmet offered for free, request wheels wiped free of gravel before entering.

**RING, STICK AND PUCK**

- Program designed for experienced skaters 4yrs+ to practice their hockey and ringette skills; no 1 on 1 learning
- 24 skaters maximum
- Skaters supply their own stick and mandatory hockey gloves
- \* No goalies or shinny/scrimmage due to safety
- \*\* No R/S/P Wed. March 23 and 25.

**ADULT HOCKEY REQUIREMENTS**

- Check in at Arena Reception prior to ice access
- Informal non-contact game led by players
- Maximum 20 participants
- Two free goalie spots for drop in games
- Full equipment required.
