

## Notice of First Three Readings

### Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 4444

The City of Port Coquitlam Council will consider First, Second and Third Reading of Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 4444 at the **regular council meeting of June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026**, in Council Chambers, City Hall, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 2580 Shaughnessy Street, Port Coquitlam, B.C.

### Intent of the Proposed Bylaw

The intent of **Bylaw No. 4444**, is to amend Zoning Bylaw, 2008, No. 3630, to remove antiquated restrictions and to clarify and expand the range of permitted entertainment and hospitality-related uses in commercial zones.

The Council meeting of **June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026**, is open to the public and anyone wishing to attend may do so in person by attending Council Chambers. The meeting will also be broadcast live on the City's website and can be viewed by going to [portcoquitlam.ca/council](https://portcoquitlam.ca/council).
