

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COQUITLAM

BYLAW NO. 1266

CONSOLIDATED FOR CONVENIENCE ONLY

A Bylaw to prohibit the placing of advertising
leaflets on automobiles.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Coquitlam, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall post, exhibit, or distribute placards, playbills, posters, advertising, writings, or pictures by placing them on or attaching them to vehicles that are parked or stopped on or adjacent to a highway or public place.
2. Section 1 of this Bylaw does not apply where the placards, playbills, posters, advertising, writings, or pictures have been placed upon a vehicle by or at the request of the owner of the said vehicle.
3. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw or who permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or in violation of any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who neglects to do or refrains from doing anything required to be done by any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who does any act which violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction and shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 or to imprisonment for not more than six months, or to both, the penalties being enforced and the fines and costs being recoverable upon summary conviction in the manner provided by the Offence Act R.S.B.C. 1979, c. 305 as amended.
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Leaflet Distribution Prohibition Bylaw, 1973, No. 1266".
