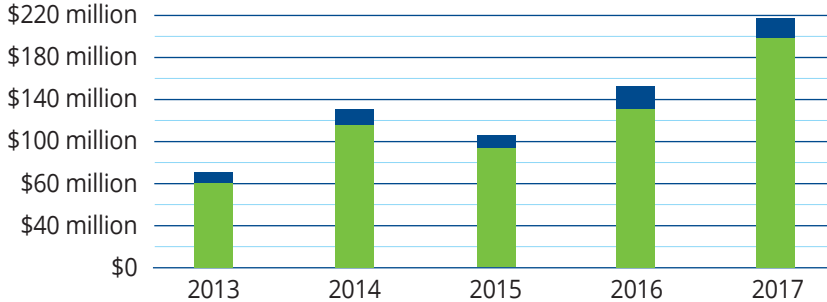


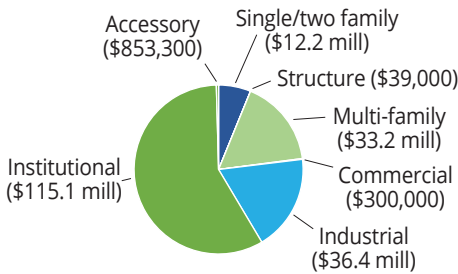

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT VALUE

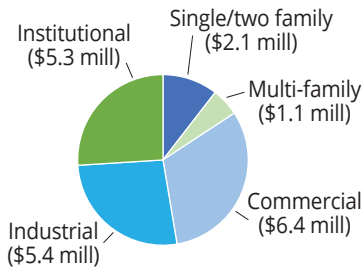
■ Total \$ value – new construction

NEW CONSTRUCTION 2017: \$198.1 MILLION

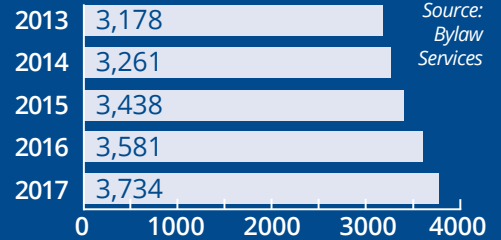


IMPROVEMENTS 2017: \$20.3 MILLION

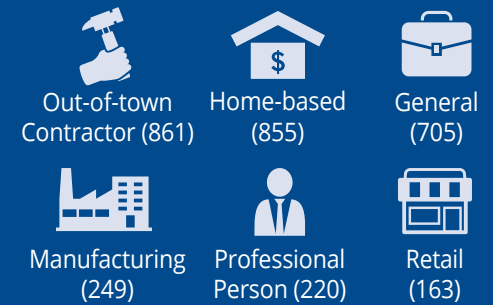
